

POSITION: RRF Program Manager

Ready Reserve Force (RRF) Program Manager will be responsible for the day-to-day technical management of PGM's Government fleet. This will involve oversight of Group Managers and Port Engineers, active participation in technical projects and new business development. Areas of responsibility will include regulatory compliance, maintenance & repair, drydockings, budgetary development & oversight, procurement and participation in the screening/selection of senior shipboard personnel.
